Thursday, April 6, except for passenger ships, essential military cargo, DST rail, and emergencies as defined in Section 5.24 of the Contract. The Union has agreed a one-hour extension up to 6:00 P.M. will be allowed to finish and sail vessels, as well as to finish any container transactions started by 5:00 P.M. Longshore workers, clerks, and foremen will be available to work a third shift.
