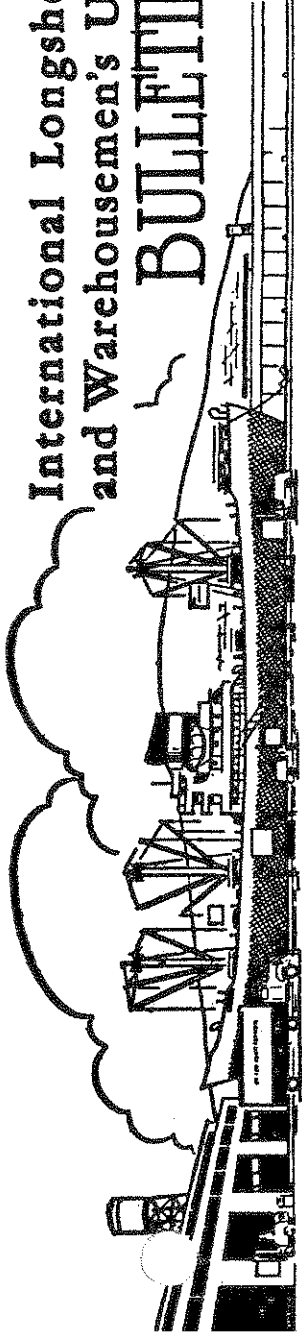

The Union has been informed by Metropolitan Stevedore Company Pier G (Bulk Terminal Berth 212) there is testing going on to lower the exposure to our members.

The testing involves a worker voluntarily wearing a monitor device for the duration of his/her job. The two types of devices either collect dust or record noise levels so the lab can determine exposure over time.
