FORKLIFT TRAINING INSTRUCTOR POSTING

Anyone interested in being a Forklift instructor may sign-up for this position with the ILWU Records Clerk at the LA/LB Longshore Dispatch Hall, 343 North Broad Avenue, Wilmington, CA 90744.

Qualified individuals must be certified and have five (5) years or more as a Class "A" Longshoreman. Applicants must also be current with all dues, fines and assessments.

SIGN-UPS FOR FORKLIFT TRAINING & CERTIFICATION

Anyone interested in being trained and certified in forklift may sign-up for this position with the ILWU Records Clerk, Ray Pearson at the Dispatch Hall. Individuals applying will be required to take and pass a physical, drug and alcohol test. Applicants must also be current with all dues, fines and assessments.

Sign-up period will be May 1, 2006 through May 31, 2006.

MEMORIAL DAY PAID HOLIDAY

Memorial Day, May 29, 2006 will be a paid holiday. Only registered members who have 800 qualifying hours in the prior payroll year (2005) and meet the availability requirements for at least two (2) of the five (5) days Monday through Friday (exclusive of the day of the holiday) during the payroll week in which the holiday falls, will receive a paid holiday for Memorial Day. This means you must work or meet the availability requirements for at least two days, Tuesday, May 30, 2006; Wednesday, May 31, 2006; Thursday, June 1, 2006 or Friday, June 2, 2006.

Under the current contract one does not have to meet the availability if you have worked 1300 hours or more in the prior payroll year (2005) to receive the Memorial Day paid holiday.

Persons taking a vacation during the Memorial Day week must report the vacation to the Records Clerk, Ray Pearson at the Dispatch Hall on or before Friday, June 2, 2006. Persons not receiving holiday pay because of illness, injury, jury duty, etc., must file a claim with the Records Clerk before July 21, 2006 to receive Memorial Day holiday pay. The Memorial Day holiday pay will be paid on the payroll check of June 16, 2006.
