HUNGRY SHEET DISPATCH RULES

- The Hungry Sheet is the sheet used by the NIGHT DISPATCHER for dispatching Longshoremen wanting a job opportunity, (i.e., replacements, extra orders) after the hall is closed at 7:00 p.m. every night (calls start at 7:30 p.m.)
- This sheet is put out by the NIGHT DISPATCHER for any Class "A" Longshoreman who is checked-in for work that night, and for "Men who have missed their gangs and cannot check-in" (as defined in section "*Dispatching Rules for Gangs and/or Longshoremen, Rule #43.*" Class "B" Longshoremen shall be allowed to sign the Hungry Sheet provided they have not flopped a work opportunity.
