ILWU Local 13 will hold a Stop-Work Meeting on Thursday, June 1, 2006, at 7:00 P.M.

No longshore or clerk labor will be available for work from the hours of 6:00 P.M. to 3:00 A.M. Thursday, June 1, 2006, except for passenger ships, essential military cargo, DST rail, and emergencies as defined in Section 5.24 of the Contract. The Union has agreed a one-hour extension up to 6:00 P.M. will be allowed to finish and sail vessels, as well as to complete any container transactions started by 5:00 P.M.

Where no second shift is contemplated due to the Stop-Work Meeting on Thursday, June 1, 2006, longshore and clerk workers will accept comebacks from Wednesday, May 31, second shift, to Friday, June 2, second shift.

NOTIFICATION OF 2-DAY REFERENDUM ELECTION

At the May 4, 2006 Stop Work Meeting, a motion was passed and carried that set the dates for a two day referendum election regarding changing the General Rules in the Constitution. You will be voting to change the election and meeting fines. This election will take place on June 14 & 15, 2006 from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. at the ILWU Memorial Hall, 231 W. "C" Street, Wilmington, CA 90744.

You will be voting on the following:

GENERAL RULE #1 - ELECTION FINE

Change from:

All members are required to vote at all elections, regular or special, where voting if for two days or more, or be fined two dollars (\$2.00) for failure to do so, except sick or injured members and all members out of town, who have cleared with the Secretary/Treasurer.

Change to:

All members are required to vote at all elections, regular or special, where voting if for two days or more, or be fined ***half (1/2) of prevailing straight time hourly rate*** for failure to do so, except sick or injured members and all members out of town, who have cleared with the Secretary/Treasurer.

GENERAL RULE #2 - MEETING FINE

Change from:

All members are required to attend at least one meeting a month or be fined ½ of the prevailing STRAIGHT TIME HOURLY RATE. This rule does not apply to members who are sick, injured, working, or are sixty (60) years of age or over, or out-of-town and have cleared with the Secretary/Treasurer.

Change to:

All members are required to attend at least one meeting a month or be fined the ***amount equal to 1 hour*** of the prevailing STRAIGHT TIME HOURLY RATE. This rule does not apply to members who are sick, injured, working, or are sixty (60) years of age or over, or out-of-town and have cleared with the Secretary/Treasurer.
