The get-together will be hosted by the Oahu Division Athletic Association and Tournament Committee at the ILWU Local 142 Hall, 451 Atkinson Drive, Honolulu, Oahu on Friday, September 1, 2006 starting at 6:00 p.m. Tournament rules, pairing, tee-time listing and other information will be provided at this time. The entry application and entry fee of \$200.00 should be submitted to your respective Division M.S.D. or respective Sports Coordinator; who will forward them to Brian Tanaka or Brandon Bajo-Daniel. All fees must accompany your entry form. The entry fee of \$80.00 per person covers the following: Friday night get together; awards; awards dinner and general tournament expenses. No refunds will be made except in cases of emergency, as determined by the tournament committee. This shot-gun tournament will be played in five (5) flights: A, B, C, Women, and Guest.
