Supermarket Workers Locked Out by Ralphs in 2003 to Receive Record- Breaking Settlement from Grocer

On Friday, June 30, 2006, Ralphs Grocery Company admitted to their employees that they had violated the law during the 2003-2004 lock out and had reached a settlement with the U.S. Attorney. This record-shattering settlement, which will be contingent on court approval as well as the withdrawal of the union's case pending before the National Labor Relations Board, will end the federal government's case against the company for conspiracy, identity fraud, money laundering, and obstruction of justice.

Southern California Ralphs employees represented by the United Food and Commercial Workers (UFCW) Union who were locked out on October 11, 2003, along with their trust funds and local unions, will receive a settlement of \$50 million, the largest such settlement in the history of the United States. The company will also pay \$20 million in fines to the federal government.
