### COMEBACKS

Individuals with comebacks are committed to the employer until such time as they are released to the hall (until the job is completed). Volunteering off the floor applies to specific cases, such as men who miss their gang; you cannot check in because the job in which you called a replacement for is still working.

If you are working, don't ask the foreman to release you. It is your right to call a replacement. You are still responsible to the job is the job is still working! The employer doesn't call a reap or extra order for your job. Cover your own hide! Call a reap if you need the day off. Don't gimmick and try to come back to the hall the next day to sharp shoot again!

### HARRY BRIDGES BIRTHDAY PAID HOLIDAY

Harry Bridges Birthday, Friday, July 28, 2006 is a paid holiday. Only registered persons who have 800 qualifying hours in the prior payroll year (2005) and meet the availability requirements for at least two (2) of the five (5) days exclusive of the holiday Monday through Friday will receive a paid holiday for Harry Bridges birthday. This means you must work or meet the availability requirements for a lease two (2) days Monday, July 24; Tuesday, July 25; Wednesday, July 26 and Thursday, July 27, 2006.

Under the current contract one does not have to meet the availability requirement if you worked 1300 hours in the prior payroll year (2005) to receive the Harry Bridges holiday pay.

Persons taking a vacation during the holiday week must report the vacation to the Records Clerk in the dispatch hall on or before July 28, 2006 or you will not receive the holiday pay. Persons not receiving holiday pay because of illness, injury, jury duty, etc., must file a claim with the Records Clerk on or before September 15, 2006.

The Harry Bridges holiday pay will be paid on August 11, 2006.
