### UPDATE ON DOUBLE BACK

On August 3, 2006 the Employer took the Union to arbitration over the issue of Double Back. The Arbitrator ruled that absent any agreement between the Union and PMA there shall be NO DOUBLE BACK until such agreement is reached.

**SO this means NO DOUBLE BACK!**

### 9.41

*“Trained and/or qualified skilled men shall accept work in their skill when checked in for work or while working in other categories. Failure to do so shall result in removal from the qualification list of the skill in which they are failing to work, and such men shall not be eligible for future promotion or future skilled training programs.”* PMA is no longer filing complaints against trained individuals who bypass a skilled job opportunity. They are now imposing unilateral penalties on individuals who fail to cover CY, CL and H/L (Heavy Lifts) jobs dispatched through the Joint Dispatch Hall. This is a violation of the individuals’ right under Section 17 of the PCLCD.
