On August 7, 2006 the Committee agreed to amend the following agreement made in Meeting No. SCLB-0138-2006, July 11, 2006:

The Committee agreed that Class "B" longshore workers are eligible for comebacks on all jobs, including CY and heavy lifts, seven days a week on a 60-day trial basis.

"Trained and/or qualified skilled men shall accept work in their skill when checked in for work or while working in other categories. Failure to do so shall result in removal from the qualification list of the skill in which they are failing to work, and such men shall not be eligible for future promotion or future skilled training programs."
