### SPECIAL BULLETIN

Arbitration Award SCAA-35-2004 mandated the Local to have an Addenda List of 25 Longshoremen who are eligible for steady crane postings. The decision was as follows:

Local 13 shall maintain a minimum of twenty-five (25) longshoreman on a list. (For clarification, this list to be named "Addendum List").

1. The following is the criteria that shall govern eligible longshoremen to be placed on the Addendum List:
  - a. Must have five (5) years as a Class "A" longshoremen.
  - b. Must have worked one hundred twenty-five (125) hours on crane rated equipment during the preceding twelve (12) months.
  - c. The Addendum List shall be made available to the employers when requested.
2. The selection and qualifying procedures shall be followed as written below.
  - a. A longshoreman is selected by an individual employer for a steady crane position from the Addendum List.
  - b. The parties involved at this stage (employer, selected longshoremen and crane instructor) shall schedule this individual to be tested in regards to competency.
  - c. The selected longshoreman shall be directed and monitored solely by the crane instructor as recognized in phase two of the crane training program.
  - d. All criteria shall be established by the instructors and the certification or non-certification shall be final.
  - e. Upon certification the selected longshoremen shall pass the identical physical administered to crane trainees'.
  - f. A selected individual must remain a steady crane driver for the employer who selected him for a minimum of one year.
  - g. If the longshoreman is terminated for cause or voluntarily resigns, his certification shall be considered nonexistent. The only exception to the above is if the employer ceased operations in the LA/LB Harbors.
  - h. All costs incurred shall be assumed by the individual employer seeking the steady crane operator.
  - i. ILWU Local 13 shall create the Addendum List before the close of business on December 17, 2004.
  - j. The Area Arbitrator shall retain jurisdiction of this issue in its entirety.

If anyone feels that they would qualify to be on the Addenda List please bring an Occupation Code printout from the Pacific Maritime Association payroll office in Wilmington for the past four quarters to the Records Clerk, Ray Pearson..

Calls will be made to individuals who qualify to be on this Addenda List to ensure that they accept being on the Addenda List. This list will only be implemented when trained and certified individuals fail to apply for steady crane postings at the Joint Longshore Dispatch Hall.
