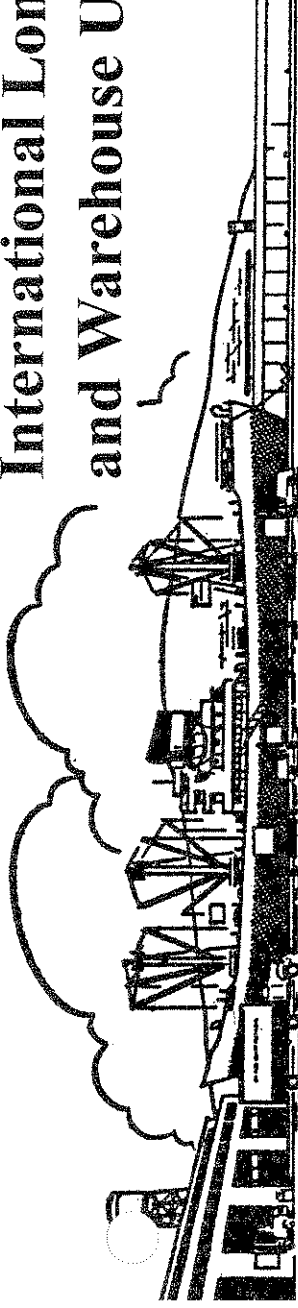

### Reminder... STOP-WORK MEETING THURSDAY, NOVEMBER 9, 2006

ILWU Local 13 will hold a Stop-Work Meeting on Thursday, November 9, 2006, at 7:00 p.m. at the ILWU Memorial Hall.

### VETERAN'S DAY PAID HOLIDAY

Veteran's Day, Saturday, November 11<sup>th</sup>, is a paid holiday. Only registered people who have 800 qualifying hours in the prior payroll year (2005) and who meet the availability requirements for at least two of the five days (exclusive of the holiday) Monday through Friday will receive a paid holiday for Veteran's Day. This means that you must work or meet the availability requirements for at least two days, Monday, November 13<sup>th</sup>, Tuesday, November 14<sup>th</sup>, Wednesday, November 15<sup>th</sup>, Thursday, November 16<sup>th</sup>, and Friday, November 17<sup>th</sup>, 2006.

Under the current Contract, one does not have to meet the availability requirements if you have worked 1300 hours in the prior year (2005) to receive the Veteran's Day holiday pay.

People taking a vacation during the holiday week must report the vacation to the Records Clerk before Friday, November 17, 2006 in order to receive the Veteran's Day holiday pay. People not receiving holiday pay because of illness, injury, jury duty, etc., must file a claim with the Records Clerk before January 6, 2007.

**THANKSGIVING DAY**  
**PAID HOLIDAY**

Thanksgiving Day is November 23, 2006 and it will be a paid holiday. Only registered people who have 800 qualifying hours in the prior payroll year 2005 and who meet the availability requirements for at least two of the five days, Monday through Friday (exclusive of the day of the holiday) during the payroll week in which the holiday falls will receive a paid holiday for Thanksgiving Day. This means you must work or meet the availability requirements for at least two days, Monday, November 20<sup>th</sup>, Tuesday, November 21<sup>st</sup>, Wednesday, November 22<sup>nd</sup>, and Friday, November 24<sup>th</sup>, 2006.

Thanksgiving Day is one of the holidays that everyone has to meet the two days availability requirements. Any person intending to take a vacation during the Thanksgiving week must report their vacation to the Records Clerk at the Dispatch Hall on or before November 24, 2006. Any person not receiving holiday pay because of illness, injury, jury duty, etc., must file a claim with the Records Clerk on or before January 12, 2007.

The Thanksgiving holiday pay will be paid on the paycheck issued on December 8, 2006.
