### CESAR CHAVEZ BIRTHDAY PAID HOLIDAY

Cesar Chavez Birthday is Saturday, March 31, 2007, is a paid holiday. Only registered persons who have 800 qualifying hours in the prior payroll year (2006) and meet the availability requirements for at least two (2) of the five (5) days (exclusive of the holiday) Monday through Friday will receive a paid holiday for Cesar Chavez Birthday. This means you must work or meet the availability requirements for at least two (2) days Monday, April 2, 2007; Tuesday, April 3, 2007; Wednesday, April 4, 2007; Thursday, April 5, 2007 and Friday, April 6, 2007.

Under the current contract, one does not have to meet the availability requirements if you worked 1300 hours in the prior payroll year (2006) to receive Cesar Chavez Birthday holiday pay.

Persons taking a vacation during the holiday week must report the vacation to the Records Clerk before Friday, April 6, 2007. Persons not receiving holiday pay because of illness, injury, jury duty, etc., must file a claim with the Records Clerk before Friday, May 25, 2007.

The Cesar Chavez Birthday holiday pay will be paid on the pay check of April 20, 2007.

Note: Under the current contract when a holiday falls on a Saturday, there is no provision to pay overtime on Friday or Monday.

## SAFETY TALK FORM

The Officers of Local 13 are asking all individuals **not** to sign the pre-shift safety talk forms before the start of the job. If the employer's insist you sign, you need to call the Business Agent. There is no agreement between the Union and Employers to have anyone sign these forms.
