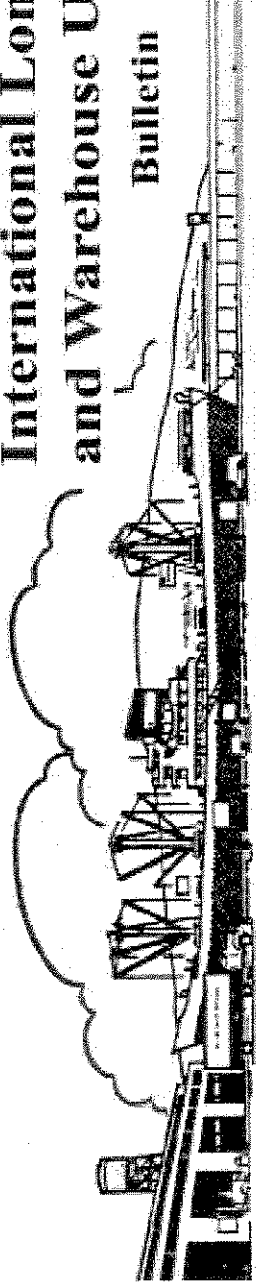

### ATTENTION ALL INDIVIDUALS ON THE "B" CRANE BOARD

After all training is successfully completed, you may check-in on the B-Crane Board days or nights. You must complete 200 hours before you may be considered for elevation to the Class A Primary Crane Board.

It is your responsibility to inform the Crane Training Department once you have completed the 200 hours worked from the B Crane Board in order to be considered for elevation to the Class A Primary Crane Board. See Kimberly at the PMA Training Center.

Elevation review is done quarterly. This quarterly meeting is tentatively scheduled for June 29, 2007.

### MEMBERS MEETING EMPLOYERS

To all workers Class A or B, Steady or Hall. It is unwise to meet with the Employers to discuss any issue without Union representation. (We are not talking about those arising under Section 11 of the PCLCD). # CRANE TRAINING SIGN-UP LIST

The names of eligible members that are interested in crane training may be entered on the Crane Training Sign-up List at the Records Clerk's Office. **The Sign-up List will start on Tuesday, May 1, 2007.** The deadline for entering the names on the Sign-up List shall be Thursday, May 31, 2007 at 3:30 p.m. at the Records Clerk's Office.

To sign-up on the Crane Training List, **you must first obtain** the "Notice of Eligibility" form in the Dues Office and meet the following requirements:

1. Five (5) years of Class A longshore registration; Any member that does not have their "5 years in the hold" by the deadline date set for any crane training sign-ups shall not be eligible for training for that sign-up period.  
This would also include mechanics that have not met their obligation under the MOU Letter of Understanding - Mechanic Employment Requirement dated November 23, 2002, specifically after twelve (12) years of steady mechanic employment. A mechanic shall receive full dispatch hall check-in rights, including transfer and promotion. After fifteen (15) years of service, a mechanic shall receive full check in rights and promotions. If anyone does not meet these obligations, they shall wait until they become fully eligible to sign up on the following Crane Training Sign-up List.
2. Dues, fines, and assessments must be paid in full, with a zero (0) balance, substantiated by presenting the "Notice of Eligibility" from the Dues Office to the Records Clerk at the time of sign-up;
3. Current telephone number and address shall be on file with the Dues Office, substantiated by presenting the "Notice of Eligibility" from the Dues Office to the Records Clerk at the time of sign-up;
4. Know your sign-up sequence number and the date you signed-up.
