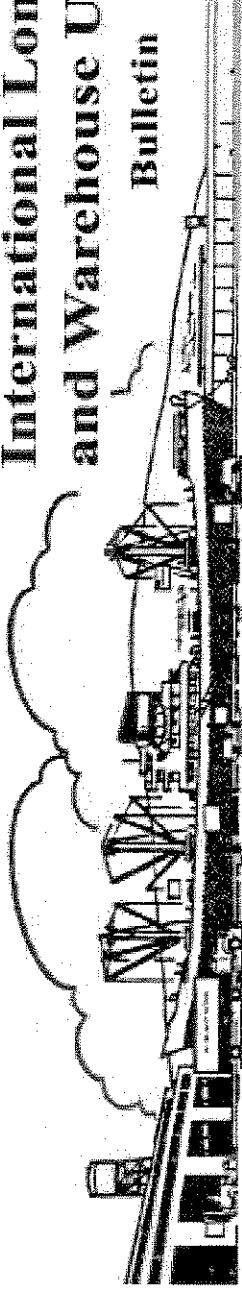

HOW TO WRITE A RESOLUTION

“WHEREAS”

Whereas means *because or considering that*. MANY OF THE RANK AND FILE OF LOCAL 13 HAVE LITTLE OR NO EXPERIENCE WITH CAUCUS explaining a problem that we hope to solve, or RESOLUTIONS an unsafe work condition that we hope to remedy.

“AND WHEREAS”

If there is more than one reason for making the IDEAS FOR THE CONTRACT FROM THE Resolution, the argument for the Resolution RANK AND FILE CAN CONTRIBUTE TO A proceeds through separate logical steps. We FINER CONTRACT AND BETTER LIFE ON introduce new components with the phrase THE WATERFRONT “*and whereas*.”

“THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED”

Here is the actual Resolution. This is where we THE DELEGATES SHALL PREPARE A define the action we want to take. If this SIMPLE EXAMPLE TO BE USED TO involves adding to or changing the language of INSTRUCT THE RANK AND FILE AS TO the Agreement, be precise about which Section THE FORM, CONTENT, AND PURPOSE OF we are talking about. THE RESOLUTION
