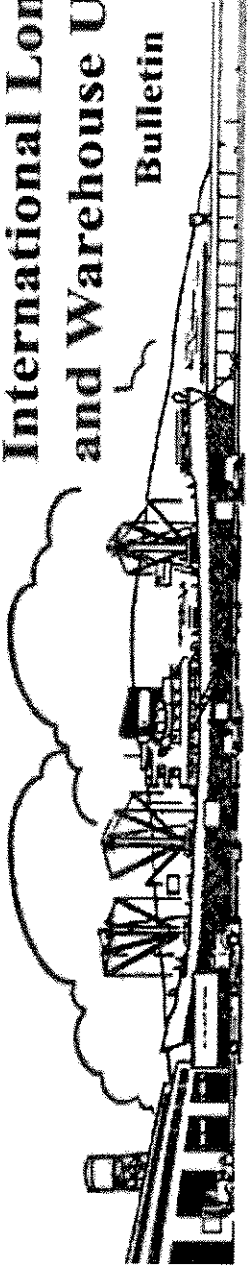

DISPATCH TIMES FOR SKILLED III JOBS

At the Stop Work Meeting held on October 4, 2007, the membership approved to reinstate the Supplementary B-CY Board (called "B-CY Board/List") with those Class "A" members with less than five (5) years to be also checked-in on the B-UTR as their primary board. With this adoption, the membership further accepted the Employers proposal that all Skilled III jobs shall be dispatched at 6:05 a.m. and 4:05 p.m. for day and night dispatch respectfully.

This means that **effective Thursday, November 1, 2007**, dispatch for the following boards will begin at **6:05 a.m.** and **4:05 p.m.** for ALL jobs, whether Flex or Regular:

CRANE BOARDS
CY BOARD & B-CY LIST
WINCH BOARDS

Please note the above changes. The Officers appreciate your cooperation during these dispatch changes.

B-CY BOARD/LIST & B-UTR

Software changes are in process for the reactivation of the Supplementary B-CY Board (called "B-CY Board/List"). It is anticipated the implementation date is scheduled for November 1, 2007. The first dispatch session will occur on Thursday, November 1, 2007 for both morning and evening dispatch.

Trained and certified CY Operators, with less than 5 years Class "A", will be required to check-in on both the B-UTR & B-CY Board/List with their total hours worked for the month on their respective shifts. Those individuals, who did not work or flopped, would be carried over to zero (0) hours the next day.

The following rules would then apply:

1. All members that are CY trained, with less than five (5) years Class "A" experience shall check-in on the B-UTR Board with total hours worked to follow low man out procedure.
2. All CY certified members with less than five (5) years Class "A" experience, shall check-in on the "B" CY Board/List with total CY hours worked to follow low man out procedure.
3. The "B" CY Board/List shall operate in the same manner as the Supplementary Crane Board when volunteering for jobs out of the CY category, Individuals shall volunteer for all category work from hours checked-in from the B-UTR Board.

Following implementation of the above mentioned and of the above noted method of dispatch, the committee shall meet every thirty (30) days to review the condition regarding such board and its effect with dispatch. Further, the Union's B-UTR/B-CY committee shall meet with the LRC committee after the thirty (30) day review to discuss monitoring the implementation of the dispatch changes.
