ILWU LOCAL 13 STOP-WORK MEETING THURSDAY, APRIL 3, 2008

ILWU Locals 13 will hold a Stop-Work Meeting on Thursday, April 3, 2008, at 7:00 p.m. at ILWU Local 13, 231 W. "C" Street, Wilmington.

No longshore, marine clerk, or foremen labor will be available for work from the hours of 6:00 p.m. to 3:00 a.m. Thursday, April 3, 2008, except for passenger ships, essential military cargo, DST rail, and emergencies as defined in Section 5.24 of the Contract. The Union has agreed a one-hour extension up to 6:00 p.m. will be allowed to finish and sail vessels.

Where no second shift is contemplated due to the Stop-Work Meeting on Thursday, April 3, 2008, workers will accept comebacks from Wednesday, April 2, second shift, to Friday, April 4, second shift.

CESAR CHAVEZ BIRTHDAY PAID HOLIDAY

Cesar Chavez Birthday, Monday, March 31, 2008 is a paid holiday. Only registered persons who have eight hundred (800) qualifying hours in the prior payroll year (2007) and meet the availability requirements for a least two (2) of the five (5) days (exclusive of the holiday) Monday through Friday will receive a paid holiday for Cesar Chavez Birthday. This means you must work or meet the availability requirements for at least two (2) days, Tuesday April 1, Wednesday April 2, Thursday April 3 and Friday April 4, 2008.

Under the current contract one does not have to meet the availability requirements if you worked thirteen hundred (1300) hours in the prior payroll year (2007) to receive Cesar Chavez Birthday holiday pay.

Persons taking vacation during the holiday week must report the vacation to the Records Clerk before Friday April 4, 2008. Persons not receiving holiday pay because of illness, injury, jury duty, etc., must file a claim with the Records Clerk before Friday May 23, 2008.

The Cesar Chavez Birthday holiday will be paid on the paycheck of April 18, 2008.

Note: Records Room extended hours during the holiday week will be Tuesday April 1, 2008 from 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
