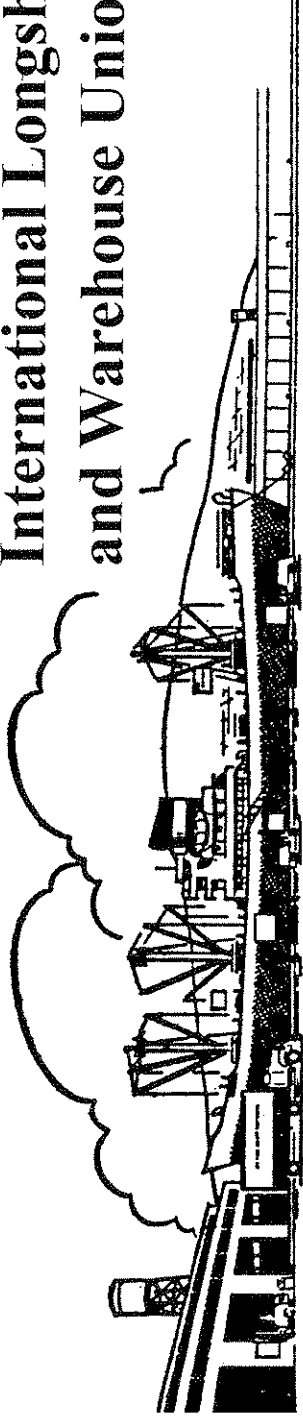
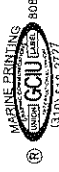

MEMORIAL DAY PAID HOLIDAY

Monday, May 31, 2010 Memorial Day will be a paid holiday. Only registered members who have 800 qualifying hours in the prior payroll year (2009) and meet the availability requirements for at least two (2) of the five (5) days Monday through Friday (exclusive of the day of the holiday) during the payroll week in which the holiday falls will receive a paid holiday for Memorial Day. This means you must work or meet the availability requirements for at least two (2) days, Tuesday, June 1st, Wednesday, June 2nd, Thursday, June 3rd or Friday, June 4, 2010.

Under the current contract one does not have to meet the availability requirements if you have worked 1300 hours or more in the prior payroll year (2009) to receive the Memorial Day paid holiday.

Persons taking vacation during the Memorial Day week must report the vacation to the Records Clerk in the Dispatch Hall on or before Friday, June 4, 2010. Persons not receiving holiday pay because of illness, injury, jury duty, etc., must file a claim with the Records Clerk before Friday, July 23, 2010 to receive Memorial Day paid holiday. The Memorial Day holiday pay will be paid on the payroll check of June 18, 2010.

ATTENTION ALL EQUIPMENT OPERATORS

Operators of Powered Industrial Truck (PIT) equipment must be evaluated every three years in each piece of PIT equipment:

- Forklift/Heavy Lift
- Top/Side Pick
- UTR
- Bulldozer
- Locomotive

“Operators, who have been previously certified on each piece of equipment, will be re-evaluated for the period July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2010. During this period, operators, who have had **eight (8) hours** or more of safe operation (no unresolved complaints on that piece of equipment), will be recertified on that equipment.” (CLRC minutes 09-A-04, dates changed)

In order to be re-certified you must have driven each piece of equipment a minimum of eight (8) hours since July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2010. (Please note you must have been paid a minimum of eight (8) hours, so if you only worked one hoot shift you will need to pick-up one more job). If you have not taken a job on a particular piece of equipment yet, please do so before the June 30, 2010 cut-off date. If you fail to take the job you will be required to take a one-day unpaid refresher course in order to get recertified.

MECHANIC TOOL VOUCHER

If you do not use your tool voucher by June 30, 2010 the voucher will be voided.
