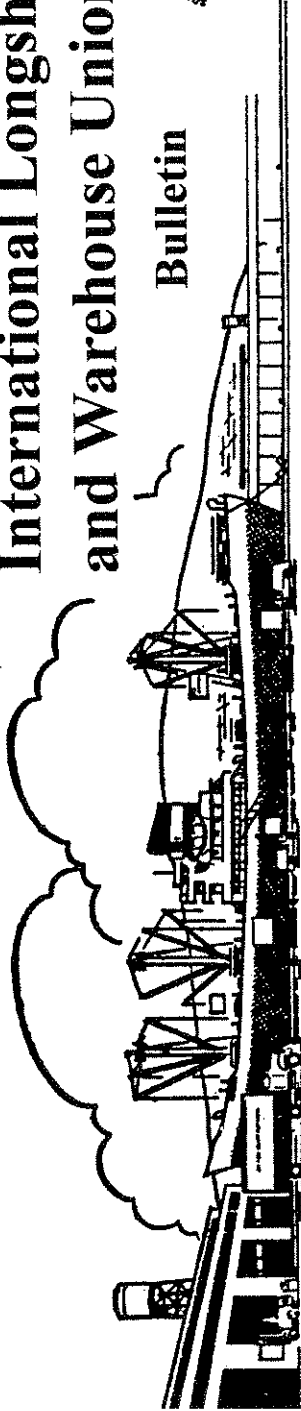
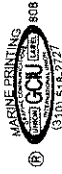

All members are reminded that the ILWU and PMA have a zero tolerance policy for graffiti and other acts that violate our ILWU/PMA 13.2 Policy on Discrimination and Harassment. Violators will be subject to severe penalties pursuant to the 13.2 Policy.

ILWU LOCAL 30 SETTLEMENT

The Brothers and Sisters of Local 30 have ratified a new six year agreement with Rio Tinto by a 75% margin. International President Robert McEllrath would like to thank all those affiliates, pension clubs, auxiliaries and the rank and file members who lent their support and helped achieve a good contract for our brothers and sisters in Local 30. This battle showed the true meaning of solidarity and "An Injury to One is an Injury to All." The International has contacted the ILWU Credit Unions up and down the coast advising them that the lockout has ended and have requested that they no longer process the weekly donations for the Local 30 lockout for which many of our members have signed up. Those affiliates, pension clubs, auxiliaries and rank and file members who have so generously donated to our brothers and sisters in Local 30 should be advised that as of May 15, 2010 – the date the contract was ratified – donations are no longer being accepted. All funds raised through May 15, 2010 will be used to support Local 30 and its members. Thank you for all of your support.

ATTENTION ALL EQUIPMENT OPERATORS

Operators of Powered Industrial Truck (PIT) equipment must be evaluated every three years in each piece of PIT equipment:

- Forklift/Heavy Lift
- Top/Side Pick
- UTR
- Bulldozer
- Locomotive

“Operators, who have been previously certified on each piece of equipment, will be re-evaluated for the period July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2010. During this period, operators, who have had **eight (8) hours** or more of safe operation (no unresolved complaints on each piece of equipment), will be recertified on that equipment.” (CLRC minutes 09-A-04, dates changed)

In order to be re-certified you must have driven each piece of equipment a minimum of eight (8) hours since July 1, 2007 through June 30, 2010. (Please note you must have been paid a minimum of eight (8) hours, so if you only worked one hoot shift you will need to pick-up one more job). If you have not taken a job on a particular piece of equipment yet, please do so before the **June 30, 2010** cut-off date. If you fail to take the job you will be required to take a one-day unpaid refresher course in order to get recertified.
