This park is located next to The Queen Mary and is just across from the ITS Terminal. The park is next to the port and it borders *along the shore*. These are two of the many reasons the park was renamed after Harry Bridges. This year's event will be a "Private Party" and access will be limited to ILWU members, casuals and our families. Please bring your family and come celebrate and remember those, who through great sacrifice, built the ILWU, the greatest union in the world.

**CHECK-IN:** All members, casuals and family will be asked to check in at the park entrance. Wrist bands with worker ID numbers will be given out, allowing access to the park. A union complaint will be filed against any member who causes disturbances. All members will be responsible for their family members and guests.

**PARKING:** Park in the Queen Mary parking lot and follow the signs that say ILWU. Please bring your parking ticket to the check-in booth and your parking will be validated for the day. Multiple validations will not be offered. **NO PARKING AT THE REEF RESTAURANT – YOUR CAR WILL BE TOWED!!**

**BLOODY THURSDAY T-SHIRTS:** Local 13 Trademark Committee will have a booth by the check-in area selling Bloody Thursday T-Shirts. Make sure to purchase one before they run out.
