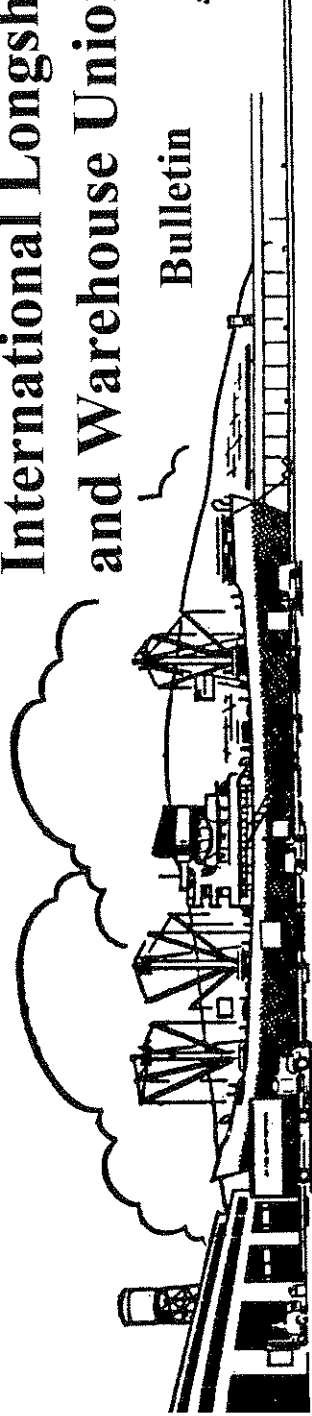

LOCAL 13 OFFICE CLOSED ON MONDAY, JULY 5, 2010

The Office will be closed on Monday, July 5, 2010 in observance of Independence Day.

FOREMEN/BOSS APPLICATION AND SELECTION PROCESS

The Joint Foreman's Labor Relations Committee (JFLRC) will be accepting applications for the Foreman/Boss position. Applications will be available at the PMA office in Long Beach (300 Oceanate, 12th Floor) for a 30-day period, commencing on July 6, 2010 until August 6, 2010. Only Longshore workers who have steady and reliable Class A registration in Local 13 for five (5) years as of July 6, 2010 are eligible to apply. (Registered mechanics are eligible only after 12 years of steady mechanic employment or after 15 years of service, pursuant to the November 23, 2002 Letter of Understanding Mechanic Employment Requirement). If you wish to apply, your original application form, plus a copy of your completed application, must be submitted by 4:00 p.m. on August 6, 2010 to PMA. Do not submit any additional information, such as resumes or photographs, with the completed applications (original and photocopy). Those wishing to obtain an application must show valid identification and may not obtain or return applications for others. Complete and sign the original application form and make two copies, one for submission and one for your records. An application not filled out completely or not signed, or not submitted with a photocopy, shall not be considered. Note: pursuant to Section 8.54 of the Foremen's Port Supplement, no applications will be accepted from applicants who have been offered and have declined registration to Foremen during the 12-month period preceding the application submission deadline of August 6, 2010.

ATTENTION ALL CLASS B WORKERS

Please be advised that beginning on Monday, July 12, 2010 all Class B Steward Meetings **WILL BE MANDATORY**. Individuals absent from Class B Steward Meetings without a valid excuse will be held back from elevation for two weeks. Absences prior to July 12, 2010 will be excused. All other Class B elevation criteria remain in full force and effect.

FORKLIFT/HEAVYLIFT TRAINING

Anyone interested in being trained and certified in forklift/heavylift may sign-up for this position with the Records Clerk at the Dispatch Hall. Individuals applying will be required to take and pass a physical, drug and alcohol test. Applicants must also be current with Union dues. Sign up period will be July 6, 2010 through August 6, 2010 @ 3:00 p.m.

AUTO JOBS

The Employers have reported that several vehicles have been damaged at the auto jobs. Please be very careful when driving the vehicles off the ship. If a vehicle is damaged, please notify the Foreman immediately ***before*** you drive it off the ship!

Remember the following:

- Clean safety vest required & No shorts allowed
- Drive safely at all times
- No leaning on or unnecessary touching of vehicles
- Do not back up unless guided by your Foreman
- Turn steering wheel slightly to the left at breakout
- Keep a safe distance between the car you are driving and the car immediately in front of you.
