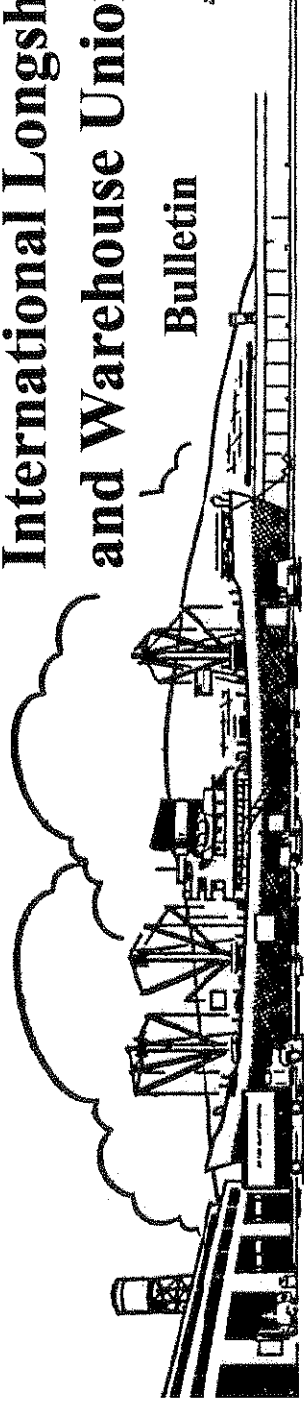

CLERK TRANSFER APPLICATIONS WAIVER OF WORK HOURS

Applications for Clerk Transfer are now available and must be completely filled out, signed, and returned in person to the Pacific maritime Association's office in Long Beach **no later than noon on Thursday, September 2, 2010**. PMA's address is 300 OceanGate, 12th Floor, Long Beach, CA. Applications will be received by PMA Monday through Friday, between 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. (PMA is closed between the hours of 12:00 – 1:00 p.m. for lunch) **Late applications will not be accepted.**

In accordance with Supplement I-A and Supplement II of the Pacific Coast Longshore and Clerk Agreements and Section 5 of the Coastwise Rules, *transfer applicants must have worked the required hours to have qualified for a two (2) week basic vacation in each of the previous two (2) years*. This requirement may be waived for up to a maximum of one (1) year for individuals off work due to industrial illness or injury. For example: If transfers are taken in 2010, good years for both 2008 and 2009 are required. Should transfers not take place until 2011, good years for both 2009 and 2010 are required.

According to both PMA and the Coast Committee, Referrals for Waiver of Work Hours are NOT being reviewed, accepted or approved at this time due to there being no formal request by Local 63 to transfer individuals. Any individual wishing to submit a Waiver Request or Referral will need to submit documentation at such time as transfers take place. Please do not submit anything to Local 13 at this time.

An outline of requirements in order to submit a Waiver request is available at the reception desk in the Local 13 offices located at 630 S. Centre Street, San Pedro, CA 90731. **Please make sure to compile the necessary documentation and hold it in your possession until such time as transfers commence.**
